New drive to boost skills in science, engineering, manufacturing and technology industries

A new agreement between the government and employers will attempt to tackle skills shortages in key industries. As part of the arrangement with Semta, the Sector Skills Council (SSC) for science, engineering and manufacturing industries in the UK, the government has earmarked £65 million from its Train to Gain budget to invest in the skills of the sectors' workforce. Learners success rates continue to increase

Figures published by the Learning and Skills Council show that the success rates of learners in further education (FE) colleges and work based learning (WBL) are high and continue to improve. Success rates in FE colleges across all ages for the academic year 2006/2007 have reached a new high of 78% - a significant rise on the 53% attained ten years ago. Ymgyrch newydd i hybu sgiliau mewn diwydiannau gwyddoniaeth, peiriannu a gweithgynhyrchu

Research highlights lack of progress for black and minority ethnic college staff

Research carried out by the Centre for Excellence in Leadership has found that despite the publication of a landmark report by the Commission for Black Staff in Further Education six years ago, the position of black and minority ethnic (BME) staff in English colleges remains largely unchanged. Continued problems of low morale and the under representation of BME staff in management roles have been highlighted by the research, of which CEL's Chief Executive, Lynne Sedgmore has said 'This is clearly a leadership issue.'
